Administrative History

The Cisca Collection was processed in 2003 and the Memory Book of the Martin Carrabine, S.J. Golden Jubilee celebration was located early in 2004. Reference had been made to the memory book in the collection Jubilee section so this addendum expands and adds many jubilee celebration and Cisca photos and details to the collection.

Margaret (Megs) Mitchell Langdon and John Langdon, very active Ciscans and friends of Father Carrabine, with the help of a dedicated committee of former Ciscans, planned and organized the celebration. It was a very large, joyful celebration of their Cisca director and friend.

Scope and Content.

The material spans the years from 1938 to 2004 comprising 2.59 linear feet.

Series

Series 1: Golden Jubilee of Fr. Carrabine, 1963, undated. Boxes 1 – 3

Contains photos of the Jubilee liturgy and reception. The liturgy was celebrated at the Madonna Della Strada Chapel at Loyola University Chicago with a homily by Father John Egan. The luncheon and reception followed at Mundelein College. Xerox copies of some of the first pages of the memory book are also included. Approximately 600 congratulatory notes, cards, letters and telegrams were sent to Carrabine and were pasted in the memory book. A small section of cards identified as from Ciscans, relatives and friends have been listed as “special cards”. All the cards and notes reflect sincere admiration and love for all the years of service and pastoral care Father Carrabine gave so generously.

Series 2: Material received in response to Brother Grace’s request, 1937-1964, undated. Boxes 4-5

Contains material and many photos about Cisca events and activities. Probably the material is from the request of Brother Grace for Cisca memorabilia for the Cisca collection. Some donors

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are identified—among them are the Langdon's, George Fleming, Buckley, Joan Smith O'Gara (the secretary of Carrabine), and Sister M. Benetta of Maria High School. Many snapshots and group pictures are included. There are pictures of general Cisca meetings, Summer School of Catholic Action weeks, a trip to St. Louis to see Father Daniel Lord, S.J, parties at the Langdon's, school groups and pictures of Carrabine with Ciscans. Some persons are identified. Negatives of the photos are in the negative file of University Archives.
