Biographical Sketch

Born March 16, 1860, in Brock Township, Ontario, Canada, to Winthrop and Laura (Moore) Johnson, Charles N. Johnson attended Port Perry High School in Ontario. He received his L.D.S. from the Royal College of Dental Surgeons, Toronto, in 1881, and his M.D.S. from the same school in 1921. In 1885 Johnson received his D.D.S. from the Chicago College of Dental Surgery. He married Fannie Patterson on March 7, 1883, and they had two children, Mignon and Nelyon. Johnson practiced dentistry in Chicago and was the Dean of Students, Professor of Operative Dentistry, and eventually Dean of the Chicago College of Dental Surgery. In addition, he served as the editor of the *Dental Review* (1902-1919), and of the *Journal of the American Dental Association* (1926-). He also served as president of the American Dental Association in 1925. Johnson died July 17, 1938, in Chicago.

Scope and Content

The Charles Nelson Johnson papers comprise 1.0 linear foot spanning the years 1872-1932 and include telegrams, photograph, postcards, articles and news clippings, manuscripts, and reprints. Arrangement is chronological.
