Biography

Frederick Paul Manion, S.J., was born on August 18, 1916, in Freeport, Illinois, to John Francis Manion and Ellen Kennedy Manion. He graduated from Joliet Catholic High School in 1934, moved to Milford, Ohio, and entered the Society of Jesus in August 1934. He received his bachelor's degree in 1939 from West Baden College. Manion then went to Michigan, where he received his master's degree in English from the University of Detroit in 1941. After his ordination in 1947, he studied for two years at Cambridge University and traveled throughout Western Europe. In 1958 he received his doctorate in English from Fordham University.

Fr. Manion began his academic teaching career at West Baden College. He taught at Xavier University and Milford Novitiate, where he was the Associate Dean and Prefect of Studies in the Chicago province. After being a visiting professor at Loyola University Chicago's Rome Center for one year, in 1966 Manion became an assistant professor in the Department of English at Loyola's Lake Shore Campus. He returned to teach at the Rome Center during the academic year of 1978-1979, after which he returned to Chicago.

In 1981, Fr. Manion began to work on an encyclopedia of Jesuit History. He returned once more to Rome to work on this project at the Jesuit Historical Institute until his death on June 13, 1986. His funeral and burial took place in Rome, Italy, on June 16, 1986. A memorial Mass was held at Madonna della Strada Chapel on July 5, 1986.



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Scope and Content

The Frederick P. Manion, S.J., papers comprise 2.50 linear feet spanning the years 1909 to 1976 (bulk 1934 to 1966) and include diplomas, programs, a dissertation, papers, sermons, correspondence, and photographs. Arrangement is chronological.

Notes

Description: Finding aid was migrated from legacy format to new standardized format in 2024. No other changes were made.

Processing: Accession numbers UA1986.41 and UA1996.14 were incorporated into one collection during processing.
