Administrative History

Phi Alpha Theta National History Honor Society was established on March 17, 1921 by Professor Nels Cleven at the University of Arkansas. It was formed based on the belief that the study of History was in need of an academic society designed to promote and support scholarship among its students and professors through learning, research, and publication. Today, Phi Alpha Theta has 970 chapters in universities nationwide, holding regional meetings and awarding over 25 scholarships and prizes each year.

The local Chi Mu chapter of Phi Alpha Theta was established at Loyola University Chicago on May 18, 1976. A petition to establish the chapter signed by Professors, Graduate and Undergraduate students was submitted to the International Council and Chapters of Phi Alpha Theta by the Department of History under Chairman, Professor Robert W. McCluggage.



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Scope and Content

The records of Loyola University Chicago's Chi Mu chapter of Phi Alpha Theta consist of 1.5 linear feet spanning the years 1976 to 1997. These records include chapter and national correspondence, the society constitution and manuals, membership cards, and papers submitted at the society's Illinois Regional Conference in 1989.
