Administrative History

Established in 1983, the office of the Vice President of Student Services originated in 1929 as two separate offices for male and female students – the offices of the Dean of Men and the Dean of Women. These offices continued in existence until 1969. In 1946, the office of the Dean of Students was established with both the Dean of Men and Dean of Women reporting to the Dean of Students. In 1971, the former Dean of Men and Dean of Women offices were retitled Associate Dean of Students reporting to the Dean of Students. In 1973 the office of the Dean of Students was renamed the office of the Vice President of Student Services. In 1974, Mariette M. LeBlanc was appointed the first female Vice President for Student Services, where she served until her retirement in 1987. She previously served as Associate Dean and Dean of Students at the Water Tower Campus.

During the fall semester of 1978, Student Services appointed Donna Dorl to Director of Student Activities and Assistant Dean of Students for Loyola's Lake Shore Campus. She



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earned her Bachelor's degree at the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire and her Master's degree in Education Administration at the State University of New York in Albany. She previously worked in Student Activities at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, New York, and at the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire.

Scope and Content

The Donna Dorl, Director of Student Activities, Records, consist of 1.9 linear feet spanning the years 1947-1979. Records include committee minutes, student activities member lists, correspondence, promotional materials, by-laws, and minutes, Greek pledge rosters, university calendars, awards program plans, Welcome Week plans, and Interfraternity Council and Panhellenic council memos and meeting minutes. Folders are arranged chronologically by series.

Series

Series 1: Student Activities, 1949-1979, Undated. Boxes 1-4.

This series includes student activities and club meeting minutes, correspondence, by-laws, promotional materials, member lists, and event plans. Organizations include Curtain Guild, Loyola Historical Society, Fine Arts Club, Committee on Student Life, and the Religious Welfare Committee. Event planning is included for Fall Orientation Welcome Weeks, Senior Week, Student Activities Awards Program, President's Ball, Miss Loyola, and Loyola's Centennial celebration. Correspondence related to providing tuition grants to student leaders is also included.

Series 2: Greek Life, 1947-1979, Undated. Box 4.

This series includes pledge list, rush rules, and meeting minutes and correspondence related to Greek Life at Loyola. Interfraternity Council and Panhellenic Association minutes and correspondence are included.

Series 3: Restricted, 1969-1979. Box 5.

This series includes addresses related to Greek pledges and President's Ball Invitation List, as well as rejection letters from the Student Activities Office to women wishing to pledge sororities.
